Volunteering in Monet's Gardens in Giverny, France

From April 1st to November 1st, the Munn Volunteer Program offers students the opportunity to work alongside our gardening team, assisting with deadheading, weeding, planting, watering and other forms of garden maintenance.

The internship lasts one month, and students work Monday to Friday, 8am-4pm. Volunteers receive a 250-euro stipend, along with on-site accommodation. Students share apartments and are provided free wi-fi, bicycles, and access to free laundry.

On weekends or after work, students can enjoy the beauty and quiet of Monet's small town, whether by hiking along wooded paths, visiting one of several museums in the area, or simply by appreciating the gardens after hours. In addition, Paris is only a 45-minute train ride away, and Vernon, a nearby town, is easily accessible by bike or on foot.

Some French proficiency is preferred, and students will have the opportunity to improve their French in conversation with the gardeners and fellow workers.
